ABOUT THE WORK

In my work, I use a blow torch as both disruptor and creator, crafting singular prints that mirror the transformative journey of faith. Rooted in my relationship with Jesus, each piece delves into the themes of sanctification and becoming a new creation.

The controlled chaos of the flame infuses unpredictability into the linocut process, embodying the paradox of destruction leading to creation. My works are a testament to the profound beauty born from the intersection of relationship with God and art.



SANCTIFICATION & PURITY


The inclusion & incorporation of gold in my prints marks an important step in the transformation of the series and of myself.




